

Two-Hour Delay Schedule

On occasion, the start of school may be delayed 2 hours for inclement weather. Parents are asked to watch and listen to the radio and television news. If we delay the start two hours, buses will pick up and schools will open two hours later. *For example – A student normally picked up by the bus at 7:15 a.m., will be picked up at 9:15 a.m. in the case of a 2-hour delay.* When delays occur the school dismissal time will not change on Monday through Thursday. *If there needs to be a 2-hour delay on an early release Friday, school will be dismissed at the later weekly scheduled times as shown below. There will be no Friday early release on a day with a two-hour delay. Students will attend the entire day.*

Note there is no A.M. pre-school on days with a 2-hour delay and no breakfast is served. Students will be sent home the usual way, unless a signed note is sent from the parent stating otherwise. If school is dismissed early due to weather warnings or conditions, all scheduled activities in which students are involved (practices, games, etc.) will be postponed or cancelled. Possible exceptions are high school athletic events, which will be determined by GHS administration and the participating school.
