Dear Parent/Guardian:

Schools receive certain federal and state funding (learning assistance programs, teacher incentives, etc.) based on the number of children from households that are at or below the federal poverty level. This Family Income Survey provides your child’s school a way to collect household income information. This information makes sure your child’s school receives the full amount of federal and state funding and makes sure your child receives services they are entitled to when free/reduced price applications are not collected.

It is important that you complete this survey. Please complete and return this form to **your child’s school office** before October 2, 2017 or within 10 days of enrolling into the Grandview School District.

Part 1. ELIGIBILITY: Look at the income chart below. Find your household size and circle it. Then, figure out your total household income. If your total household income is equal to or less than the amount listed for your household size, check the box indicating a “YES”. If it is more than the income listed for your household size, check the box indicating a “NO.”

This includes wages, social security, pension, unemployment, welfare, child support, alimony, and any other cash income. If including a foster child as part of the household, you must also include the foster child's personal income. Do not count foster payments as income.
