Welcome back to Grandview Middle School Athletics! If you already registered your athlete last year at GMS for any sports, FamilyID will remember your profile information. Here are directions to register **if you already have a FamilyID account.**

1. Click on FamilyID website: <https://www.familyid.com/pages/home>
2. Click on *Log in*
3. Type in your email and password you used last year
4. This will bring up your profile. Click on *Grandview Middle School*
5. Select the *Grandview Middle School Fall 2017 Fall Athletic Registration*
6. Click on *Register Now*
7. Select what sport you want to play
8. Under Participant Info section, Click on the “*click here to select participant*”
9. Find your Athlete’s name in the pulldown menú and click on that name

Your information should now be automatically entered for you. Please check through all sections and make edits to profile information as necessary.

10. Please read through all GMS policies and Athletic Code to ensure your student athlete understand GMS School Athletic expectations.
11. A parent/guardian will have to electronically sign all policy statements at the end of the registration form.
12. Click *save and continue*
13. Click *Submit registration* and you are complete.
