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### **Essential Functions**

- Complete all documentation in a timely manner for the purpose of keeping accurate records or treatment.
- Consultant to coaching staff on conditioning, nutrition, and protective equipment for the purpose of developing a comprehensive athletic training program.
- Develop and cultivate contacts with referring physicians, businesses, schools, coaches and other referral sources; provide services based on written referrals from medical provider for the purpose of establishing outreach with local providers/services.
- Maintain a daily treatment log for the purpose of maintaining accurate treatment and health records.
- Maintain accurate records of injuries, treatments, and referrals for the purpose of maintaining accurate treatment and health records to provide to coaches, parents, and administrators.
- Participate in the development and implementation of an emergency action plan for the purpose of providing a safe environment for student athletes'.

- Promote safe and appropriate practice and competition for the purpose of providing a safe training schedule for student athletics.
- Provide training to high school students, who are interested in assisting student athletes and the athletic trainer for the purpose of student engagement and career interest/research.
- Provide on-call athletic trainer services via telephone for all sports offered by the district for the purpose of providing athletic training services and treatment recommendations.
- Responsible for prevention, emergency care, first aid, evaluation, and rehabilitation of injuries to athletes under his/her care for the purpose of ensuring an athletics safety.
- Assist the athletic director as requested for the purpose of maintaining a high quality athletic program.
- Assist with prevention of injuries including education for athletes and Student Athletic Trainers, identifying factors that put athletes “at risk”, correcting deficiencies in Athletes as deemed necessary, as well as taping and bracing for the purpose of prevention and education.
- Evidence of WIAA certification, and compliance with WIAA and district rules and regulations for the purpose of meeting athletic eligibility rules and district participation rules.
- Liability Insurance shall be obtained and maintain appropriate liability insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000 per occurrence for the purpose of legal compliance.
- Participate in the development and implementation of a comprehensive athletic health care system for the purpose of providing a comprehensive student athletic training program.
- Provide services for practices, home and some away athletic contests, and post-season athletic contests for the purpose of providing preventive training services.
- Provide the coaches and athletic director with a list of athletes medically eligible to compete under district and state rules and regulations for the purpose of student athlete safety and eligibility requirements.
- Provide emergency care and first aid including availability of necessary equipment, communication procedures for emergency situations, and prompt, Accurate triage for the purpose of student athletics safety.
- Provide education in the areas of: 1.sports injury prevention and care, 2.nutrition and exercise, 3.healthy lifestyles, 4.exercise regimens for the purpose of provided preventive sports training services.
- Review student physicals and releases to ensure authenticity for the purpose of maintaining student safety and eligibility standards.
- Serve as liaison between the team physician, school nurses or student’s health care provider, the athlete, the athlete’s parents, and coaching staff for the purpose of providing a comprehensive training program.
